Pricing Schedule:

Early Registration (postmarked before May 31)	\$75 / week
Regular Registration (postmarked June 1-June 21)	\$95 / week
Walk-Up Registration (on-site only June 24-July 29)	\$115 / week
<i>NOTE: Day Camp will NOT be open Thurs., July 4. Payment for Week 2, before June 1, is \$60, between June 1 and June 21, is \$80, after June 21, is \$100.</i>	

To guarantee a spot for your child, registration **forms and full payment must be received by May 31**. Openings submitted after May 31 will be filled, if space is available, which is dictated by staff availability; camper-to-counselor ratios determine available spaces.

Summer 2019

- Every Tuesday, **except for week 6**, K-1 campers will take a walking field trip to the Borough Library for an hour of story time and a craft.
- Every Friday, **except week 6**, 3-6 campers will be dropped off at Mendham Health & Racquet Club for swimming until 11am. Deep-end swim tests start at 8:40am. Campers who do not pass the test can still swim in the shallow end. Campers will walk back to camp to finish out the day.
